1. Introduction

Franklin County is soliciting proposals from qualified contractors to provide general carpentry services for facility maintenance, repairs, and small-scale renovations. The selected contractor(s) will work on an as-needed basis under a time-and-materials agreement for various County buildings and properties.

2. Scope of Work

The contractor shall furnish all labor, tools, and equipment necessary to perform the following general carpentry tasks:

- Rough and finish carpentry
- Installation and repair of doors, frames, and hardware
- Drywall framing, installation, and repair
- Interior and exterior trim work
- Cabinetry repairs and installation
- Flooring underlayment or subfloor repair (not finish flooring)
- Wood-framed partition construction
- Installation of wall protection, handrails, and blocking
- Minor demolition and debris removal related to carpentry work
- Job site clean-up and safety compliance

All work must meet local building codes and ADA compliance where applicable.

3. Contract Term

The initial term of the contract shall be one (1) year, with options for up to two (2) additional one-year extensions, contingent on performance and funding availability.

4. Minimum Qualifications

Respondents must:

- Hold a valid contractor's license for carpentry/general building in [Insert State]
- Carry required insurance (General Liability and Workers' Compensation)
- Have a minimum of 3 years of professional carpentry experience
- Be able to comply with OSHA safety regulations
- Demonstrate availability for work within 72 hours of request

- o Examples from public sector or commercial clients

5. Staffing Plan

o Resumes or bios for key personnel (if applicable)

6. References

o Minimum of 3 relevant client references

- Hourly rates and cost competitiveness
- Experience and qualifications
- Responsiveness and availability
- References and past performance

• Completeness and clarity of the proposal
