Administrator's Report

- Maya Franklin has accepted the Dispatcher position at the Communications Center. Her first day will be August 4, 2026.
- Jonathan Curran has accepted the Patrol Deputy with the Sheriff's Office. His first day will be August 17, 2026.
- Major Close will be a speaker at the MCCA Conference in September regarding medical interventions at the jail.
- We are slated to receive additional Opioid Settlement funds in the three separate allotments: \$32,199.16, \$9,541.12, and \$16,895.93.
- We have received a LUPC application for Mr. and Mrs. Hilliard for the rezoning of approximately 3 acres on Cook Hill Road in Freeman Township.
- Interviews for the County Administrator position will take place on August 17, 2026, and August 18, 2026.
- As of the writing of this report, we have not received an update from the Attorney regarding the Caribou Dam Project.

Sue Ann Cochran - Emergency Watershed Protection Program

Comments: One June 17, 2025, the Commissioners along with Adam Cattrell from the NRCS met at 2709 Rangeley Road, Madrid Township to view to property and discuss the potential sponsorship for the Emergency Watershed Protection Program. The homeowner, Sue Ann Cochran, would like this matter to be revisited.

Recommendation: None at this time.

The Bingham Area Multi-Use Trail Connector Proposal Presentation

Comments: Charlie Woodworth will present a multi-county ATV trail network opportunity. Somerset County's very organized ATV/Snowmobile club is negotiating with their county and landowner, Weyerhaeuser, to secure permanence in a trail connector that will link to Franklin County and Piscataquis County. Proposed Project 1 is estimated to cost \$60,000. Somerset County will vote to invest \$20,000. Portions of these ATV trails are also Snowmobile trails. If there is interest, he would like to propose that Franklin share in the investment a \$20,000, 1/3rd of the proposed Project 1 cost, to be funded by the TIF. Project 2 and 3 will be up to Somerset County and Piscataquis County.

Western and Central Maine Regional Trail Connectors for Resilience and Access Consistency

Three coordinated low cost – high impact multi-use trail infrastructure projects supporting ATV and snowmobile connectivity, tourism, and economic activity throughout Kennebec, Franklin, Somerset, and Piscataquis Counties.

Executive Summary

Together, these projects strengthen and preserve critical multi-use trail infrastructure serving both Maine's ATV and snowmobile communities. The projects improve safety, increase trail system resilience and access consistency, reduce conflicts with commercial forestry operations, support rural tourism economies, and protect regional trail connectivity throughout Somerset, Franklin, and Piscataquis Counties. It is important to note that the new Kennebec Valley Trail connection that starts all the way down to Oakland (Kennebec County) will also benefit significantly from these connectors.

Combined Investment Summary

Core Project Total: \$142,000

Optional Proactive Infrastructure Investment: \$10,000

Project 1: East-West Franklin–Somerset Connector

Project Overview

The East-West Franklin–Somerset Connector begins in Embden at Concord Corner Road, accessed from Bert Berry Road. The trail travels through Embden, Pleasant Ridge Plantation, and into the Lexington-Kingfield region, providing a critical connection between the Somerset and Franklin County trail networks.



If you look at the larger PDF regional map, it becomes very obvious how critical this traffic funnel is for all recreational traffic coming from all points North, East and South

Regional Importance

This is the only direct east-west trail connection between the Franklin and Somerset County trail systems for ATV and snowmobile users traveling from Bingham, Solon, Moscow, Embden, Athens, Brighton Plantation, and all points north or east of Bingham. The route supports local businesses, lodging establishments, restaurants, fuel providers, and recreation-based tourism throughout the region.

Project Description

The corridor encompasses approximately 20 miles of existing trail infrastructure. Construction of approximately 1.5 miles of new trail is required to preserve this connection. Weyerhaeuser has granted provisional access to a temporary bypass route while a permanent relocation is developed. This permission expires at the end of the 2026 ATV season and if not remedied will result in closure of this connector.

Scope of Work

- Construction of approximately 1.5 miles of new trail
- Trail grading and shaping
- Ditching and drainage improvements
- Gravel placement in selected areas
- Installation of 8 culverts
- Redecking of 3 bridges
- Installation of signage
- Installation of 3 kiosks

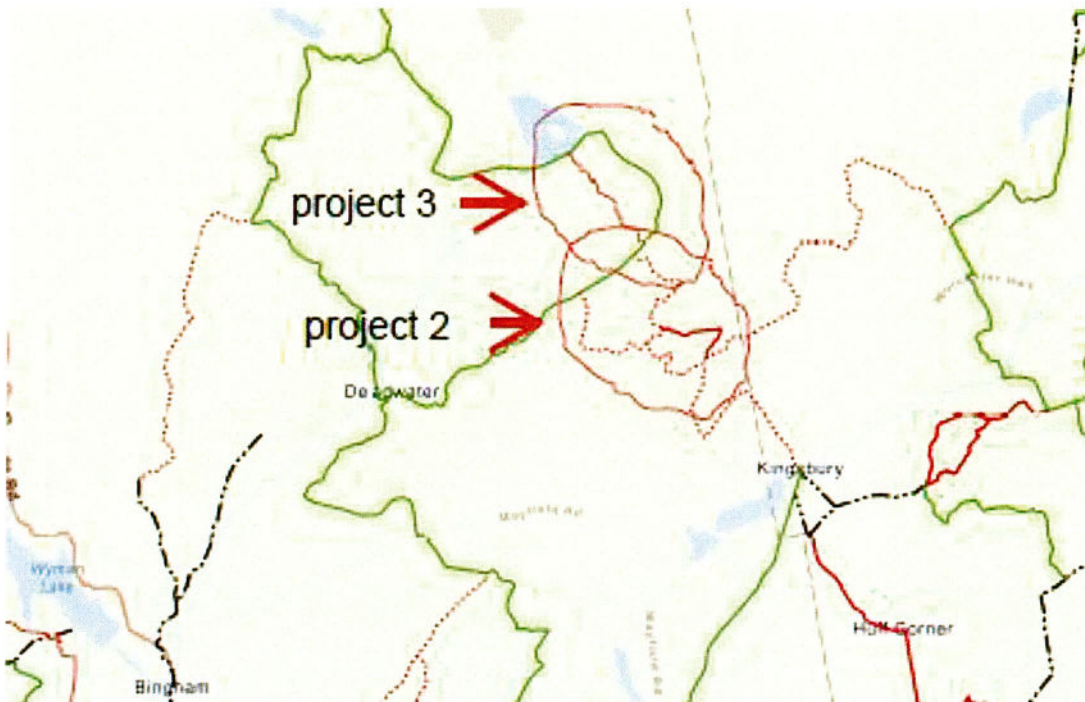
Estimated Cost: \$60,000

Optional Proactive Infrastructure Investment: Staging of a \$10,000 gravel stockpile halfway through this remote corridor for regular maintenance needs as it is hard to access due to narrow widths and steep elevation changes.

Project 2: Bingham–Moosehead Connector - Hellhole and Palmer Pond Trail

Project Overview

The Bingham–Moosehead Connector, commonly known as the Hellhole and Palmer Pond Trail, is a critical regional multi-use corridor linking the Bingham area to Greenville, Moosehead Lake, and the surrounding trail network for both ATV and snowmobile use.



NOTE: Red dotted trails are still under Weyerhaeusers' COVID response closure. This project and #3 entail existing trail (and infrastructure) repairs that are purely recreational access and do not build or provide industrial access and also opens a second route to the North for access redundancy and an alternative for bypassing logging operations

Regional Importance

Repeated interruptions have created uncertainty for trail users, businesses, lodging establishments, restaurants, fuel providers, and communities that rely on recreation-based tourism. Maintaining this connection is important to preserving regional trail continuity and economic activity.

Project Description

The primary focus of this project is reconstruction and stabilization of the Palmer Pond Stream bridge crossing. Flooding undermined bridge abutments and created ongoing safety concerns. The bridge is not used for commercial hauling or timber operations and exists solely to support recreational trail access.

Scope of Work

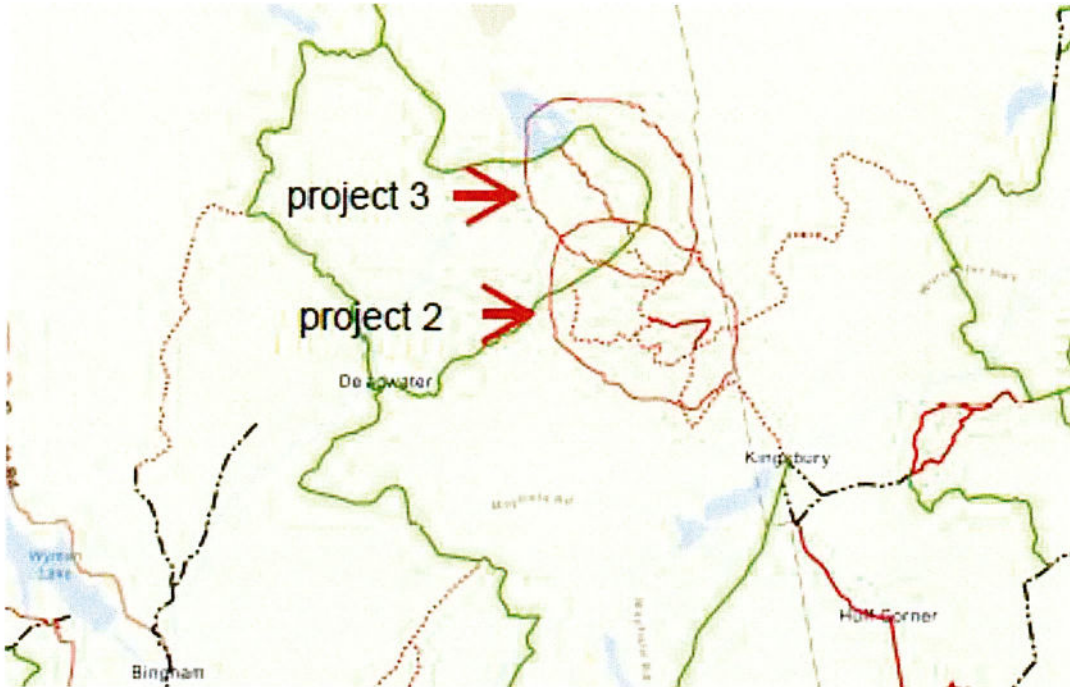
- Bridge abutment reconstruction
- Bridge reset and elevation improvements
- Bridge redecking
- Trail grading and shaping
- Ditching and drainage improvements
- Installation of 4 culverts
- Trail brushing and corridor maintenance
- Gravel placement in selected areas

Estimated Cost: \$32,000

Project 3: Bingham–The Forks Connector - Palmer Pond to Austin Pond Trail

Project Overview

The Bingham–The Forks Connector - Palmer Pond to Austin Pond Trail is a new multi-use trail development project designed to establish a dedicated recreational corridor for both ATV and snowmobile use between the Bingham area trail network and destinations north toward The Forks.



NOTE: The red line in project 3 is the creation of a new recreational only trail to bypass logging operations on the Austin pond side of this 'green loop'. A significant amount of logging has occurred in this area in the last few years, giving the trails here long term access as it is very near sustainable harvesting limits.

Regional Importance

By relocating ATV and snowmobile traffic from active logging roads onto a dedicated recreational corridor, this project will provide a more stable and predictable route, improve rider safety, and reduce conflicts with commercial forestry operations and subsequent trail closures.

Project Description

The project consists of approximately 1.5 miles of new trail construction between Palmer Pond and Austin Pond. Weyerhaeuser has granted permission for development of this permanent route to preserve access and improve long-term trail system resilience and access consistency.

Scope of Work

- Construction of approximately 1.5 miles of new trail
- Installation of 10 swamp pads
- Installation of 2 culverts
- Ditching and drainage improvements
- Excavation and bulldozer work
- Significant gravel placement and trail surfacing
- Installation of signage
- Installation of 2 kiosks
